

ABOUT US

STEM Like a Girl is a Pacific Northwest-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization whose mission is to excite and empower girls with knowledge and confidence in STEM to become future problem solvers and leaders. We are devoted to inspiring elementary school girls to develop interest and confidence in STEM through hands-on activities, parent engagement, and positive female role models. When given the right tools early on, we believe all girls have the power to develop their own STEM identity.

OUR WORKSHOPS

Our workshops are designed to provide an introduction to STEM activities for 3rd-5th grade girls and female-identifying youth. Many other STEM-based programs are costly, require a significant time commitment, or are targeted towards families already interested in science and engineering. We aim to make STEM activities available to ALL GIRLS, in particular those who don't have access to other programs. Our workshops are a great introduction to STEM for caregivers that might not otherwise consider science and engineering programs for their girls. We hope to ignite a spark in both girls and their adults to continue STEM activities at home and beyond.

At a workshop, girls have the opportunity to participate in hands-on, experiential STEM activities while learning about the design process. During these activities, we introduce the concept of "learning from failure" and how to reframe failure into a positive thing. We also host a mentor panel where female STEM professionals share their backgrounds and experiences as well as answer questions from participants. Throughout the workshop, we promote family learning by encouraging parents to work with their daughters to solve the challenges. This helps build confidence and excitement in both the girls AND their adults around STEM activities.





FAMILIES REQUESTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE




400 girls have been able to attend our workshops thanks to financial assistance

ANNUAL SPONSORSHIP LEVELS




